FRIDAY; JUNE 8th

CONTROLLED SCRIMMAGE RULES and FORMAT

30 minutes varsity / 5 minute rest / 20 minutes JV / 5 minute rest-move to new field

- 1) Each varsity team has 8 reps from the 35 yard line
- 2) Followed by each team getting 4 reps from the 20 yard line
- 3) Then each team has 4 reps from the 10 yard line
- 4) And if time permits each team has 4 reps from the 5 yard line
- 5) The JV teams start over at the 35 yard line and while time permits they will progress in the same manner.
- 6) Sportsmanship is essential and subbing freely when there are obvious mismatches will make the camp experience positive for all involved.

SATURDAY; JUNE 9th

Only the game field (Field 1 and Field 2) and the west-side practice field (closest to the road) will be used (Field 3 and Field 4).

30 minutes varsity / 5 minute rest / 20 minutes JV / 5 minute rest-move to new field

SCRIMMAGE RULES:

- 1) Each scrimmage will start at the 35 yard line with a 1st and 10 setting.
- 2) You have 4 downs to gain a 10 yard first down. When a first down is achieved the official will move it to the closest five yard marker to start the next series of downs in order to have a clear-cut first down line.
- 3) Penalties will be assessed for all infractions but the ball cannot be moved beyond the 40 yard line of your side of the field.
- 4) When a score is made you will go for the extra point from the 3 yard line (no kicking).
- 5) If a team fails to gain 10 yards in 4 downs then the other team will take over from the 35 yard line.
- 6) If turnovers are returned past the 40 yard line then consider it a score and attempt an extra-point.
- 7) Still using quick whistles but QB will have to be grabbed for the whistle to blow. The officials will make final determination on all calls made.
- 8) Please emphasize “sportsmanship” and class at all times.
